FLIGHT for HOPE TAKES OFF



The average Home Suite Hope participant lives on approximately \$1,800 a month while going to school full time. Halton is one of the most unaffordable housing markets in Ontario, while Oakville has now been named the most expensive midsized city in which to rent housing.

When apartments do become available, they are rarely below \$2600 per month, which limits our ability to take in new participants.

For our graduates, in 2020 100% of HSH's program participants were able to pay market rent independently. Today, that number has plummeted to 72%.

A one-bedroom apartment rarely hits the market for anything less than a jaw-dropping \$2600 monthly. Two-bedroom apartments command an astronomical price tag of over \$3200 a month! It's a dire situation that hampers our ability to welcome new program participants and hinders the success of our graduates.

To shed light on the struggle of single mothers to access affordable housing Oakville's Callum Wallace will take off in his single-engine plane Aug. 1 on his **Flight for Hope** journey around the world. His goal is to raise \$1 million towards HSH's affordable housing efforts. His welcome home will include HSH's brand new Home For Good Gala on Nov. 10, 2023.

FLIGHT FOR HOPE TAKES FLIGHT AUG. 1 IN SUPPORT OF HSH

'ROUND THE

On August 1st, Engel & Völkers
Oakville advisor Callum Wallace
will embark on a Flight for Hope,
taking off from Burlington Executive
Airport on a round-the-world journey



in a small single-engine aircraft. The initiative will generate a substantial contribution to Canadian charity **Home Suite Hope** and awareness to aligned charities around the world. Home Suite Hope serves the Halton Region, supporting single-parent families in their journey from homelessness to stability and self-sufficiency.

Callum's flight path covers many destinations, including: Quebec, Iqaluit, Greenland, Iceland, Scotland, Wales, England, France and Spain, Italy, Greece, Egypt, Pakistan, India, and Sri Lanka, followed by touch downs in Indonesia, Australia, New Zealand, Fiji, Samoa, and Christmas Island. The trip will end in Burlington, ON, Canada, on October 14th, before the **Home for Good Gala**, on November 10th.

Callum will pilot a V35B Beechcraft Bonanza modified to fly up to 18 hours from five. The customization includes additional fuel storage, making the vessel and its load heavier than usual. As a result, the margin for error is narrowed, especially when flying over the ocean. Only three Canadians have ever completed this journey, compared to 11 Canadians making the trip to outer space. He is the fourth Canadian to embark on this daring trip. Fewer than 150 people have attempted it.

"Home Suite Hope helps single-parent families get a second chance and get back on their feet — ' 'I'm incredibly grateful to be able to use my passion for flying to fundraise and give back to the community," says Callum.

"Flight for Hope will be hosting numerous events leading up to the August 1st departure date —locally and internationally — to foster awareness and support for the initiative. The proceeds from this event will go towards purchasing multi-unit buildings to help more families at once."

Home Suite Hope creates change through its four-year program providing homeless single parents with rental subsidies, access to childcare, transportation, two years of college education, life skills, professional development, mentorship, employment support and intensive case management. The outcomes are financial independence and long-term stability with intergenerational impact. Callum has previously worked with Home Suite Hope. In 2018 and 2019, he and his family provided property to a family enrolled in the four-year program.

"Home Suite Hope helps single-parent families overcome homelessness through our four-year program providing housing and college tuition to help the parent become independent. The cost per family is roughly \$47,000 per year," says **Sara Cumming PhD., Executive Director of Home Suite Hope**. "One of the struggles with the current housing market is finding suitable accommodation for families in the program. 'That's why funds raised through Flight for Hope will go towards financing a multi-unit dwelling."

Home Suite Hope is a non-profit organization that supports low-income, single-parent families across Halton. Its five programs unite a network of vital wraparound supports for families as they journey from poverty to stability, permanently changing lives for the better – breaking the cycle of generational poverty - one family at a time. Home Suite ' 'Hope's programming is based on the successful replica of Toronto's WoodGreen Community Services' Homeward Bound model - a four-year, employment-based program with a two-year scholarship. It offers housing, wraparound support and opportunity for single parents to secure employment by earning a post-secondary education in programs highly employable for graduates through Sheridan College. 
