A single mother with three children, already struggling financially, Debbie's diagnosis of Cancer led to 25 days of debilitating radiation treatments that cured her but left her jobless and facing eviction from her home. Today, with the help of Home Suite Hope's (HSH) **Re-Start Halton Program**, she holds a diploma in Social Service Work from Sheridan College.

Debbie is now also the proud owner of a Habitat for Humanity home and is giving

back to the HSH community about which she says:
